#### What have we been learning this week?

#### Nursery and Reception

This week nursery and reception have been learning about Remembrance Day. We have talked about the importance of the poppy and have been using a range of materials to draw and make poppies. On Thursday we walked down to the United Reformed Church to look at their cascade of knitted poppies. Today we have worked with Miss Armstrong to bake poppy seed loaves and designed bags bring them home in. Next week we are looking forward to taking part in World Nursery Rhyme week.





### Class 2 and 3

To commemorate Remembrance Day the children went for a walk to look at poppies in the local environment. We looked at the two churches and the war memorial. We then made our own poppies for us to wear and wrote a set of instructions to show how we made them. In literacy we learnt facts about hedgehogs in preparation for our new story The Hodgeheg. Well done, Year 1 and Year 2.



### Class 4

This week Year 3 have been working hard on column addition. We started off the week working on 2-digit addition using columns then we moved onto 3-digit addition. In literacy we have started to create an advert persuading people to visit Iceland. So far we have made sure to include lots of persuasive language and used this to make it sound like an interesting place to visit. In R.E we have been looking at what the main features of a church may look like. We have also looked into what role these features have in the church.

### Class 5

This week Year 4 have completed reading 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' and have had a go at writing some Viking Kenning poems describing one of the main protagonists, Fenrir the Wolf. In maths the children have done some excellent addition problem solving and reasoning work. In science we are beginning to study teeth and in P.E. we have been improving our ball skills.
