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### Class 2 & 3


Year I have settled into the classroom and are enjoying exploring and playing with the new toys and resources. They have spent time in the role play area, have enjoyed exploring a range of different materials and painted elephants for a classroom display. The children have been writing about their favourite thing to do at school and have used the word 'because' to explain why and to extend their sentences. The children have been working hard with letter and number formation and have enjoyed drawing and painting self portraits in art. A fantastic start to the year. Well done class 2!







This week Year 2 have settled in well to their new classroom and new routines. In maths we started to learn about place value. We used the tens frames, multi link and dienes to show the correct amount of tens in a number. In literacy we started our new book Goldilocks and the Three Bears and described a picture of Goldilocks using a range of adjectives. We have also started to learn about the different food groups in science. This week we had our first swimming lesson and it was enjoyed by all. Brilliant first full week in Year 2.





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#### Class 4

This week in literacy, Year 3 have been learning about adjectives and expanded noun phrases. We have also started looking at a new book called Leon and the Place Between. In numeracy we have been increasing our knowledge of place value and introducing hundreds. In music we have started to learn the different verses and chorus of 'Three Little Birds' by Bob Marley. In P.E we have been developing our ball kills, specifically our throwing and receiving.



Our key words this week are partition & descending.



### Class 5

Class 5 have settled in well and have produced some great work in their first two weeks back in school. In literacy the children have written some wonderful descriptions of themselves and have also been working on improving their grammatical knowledge. In maths we have been learning about place value in numbers including hundreds and thousands. We have also started to learn our three and four times tables. By the end of the year the children are expected to know all of their tables up to twelve times twelve. In geography we have been learning all about the continents and oceans of the world and in science we have been studying the function of human and animal teeth. In art we have created some wonderful self portraits.
