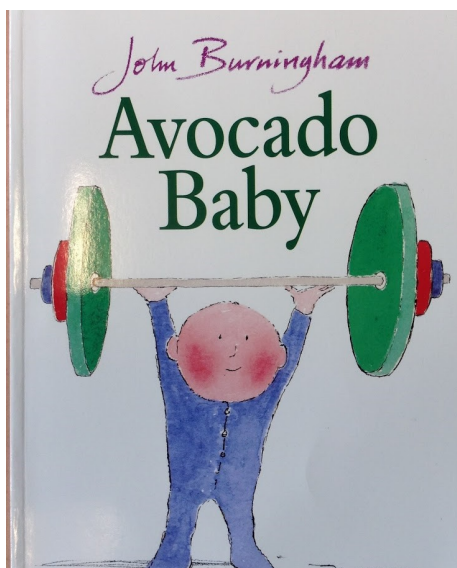

Class 2 and 3



This week year 1 and 2 have started reading *The Jolly Postman* and illustrated the route that he takes each day. The children enjoyed World Book Day activities and dressing up as their favourite characters. In Geography the children learnt about where Inuit people live and what they eat. Year 1 have enjoyed looking for signs of spring and painted beautiful daffodils. A fantastic first week!



Class 4 and 5

Year 3 and 4 have continued reading 'The Bluest of Blues' by Fiona Robinson. This week we have been investigating the character of the famous scientist Sir John Herschel.

Class 4

In our maths lessons in, we have been working on division using the bus stop method. In Science we have been focusing on electrical circuits. We have looked at the scientific symbols for bulbs, batteries and switches and we have tried to create successful circuits. This week we have started practising with an instrument called the Djembe drum.

In maths we are deepening our understanding of fractions and have just started looking at the very tricky topic of equivalent fractions. The children had a great day with local artist Anna Chapman and created some amazing flower pictures with magical properties. In Geography we have been looking at Spittal past and present and have started writing a brochure encouraging visitors.
