### <u>Class 2 & 3</u>

Year I and 2 have had a busy week in the sun. All the children enjoyed an afternoon on Spittal beach collecting shells, digging holes and building sandcastles. Everyone had a great time! The children have completed some beautiful directed drawings of toucans that live in the rainforest as part of their science work. Year I have been learning to tell the time to half past the hour in maths and have participated in fun team games in PE lessons. Year 2 have been learning to read scales by counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10 accurately and have played cricket in their PE lesson.

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### Class 4

This week class 4 have been working hard on a storyboard retell of the class story 'The Boy with Flowers in His Hair'. We finished the book and examined the moral of the story through class discussion. In numeracy we have been revisiting different aspects that we have learnt over the year. We have been practising our column addition, subtraction and multiplication, division using the 'bus stop' method and our times tables skills. We have also been revisiting the language that is used. In PSHE we have been looking at sugar in our diet. We investigated which foods are healthy and why some aren't and the affect this can have on our teeth. We also examined the sugar that is hidden in some of our favourite treats by looking at how many teaspoons of sugar are in specific foods. Key vocabulary; moral, varied and enamel.





### Class 5 & 6

Year 4 have had another busy week. We have been practising our Leavers' Assembly; thinking of our favourite memories, talking about our time in Spittal and learning two songs. In literacy we have been working hard on our spellings. We practised our spelling using School 360 and have written over 300 words! In maths we have been working on data handling. We were looking at charts and graphs and answering questions about them. On Friday we started designing our own playpark. We had loads of great ideas... water parks, climbing frames, swings, slides, cafes and benches for the adults!
